Theme : Environment / Green space	
Three key priorities for PARISH: ALCISTON	
1.	To retain the unique quality of life in Alciston and, whilst accepting that change is inevitable, seek to ensure that the character of Alciston is maintained.
2.	To seek the introduction of a viable scheme for doorstep recycling
3.	To maintain all footpaths within the Parish.

Theme : Housing	
Three key priorities for PARISH: ALCISTON	
1.	To ensure that any future development complies with existing planning regulations
2.	To maintain the existing dialogue with Wealden to ensure that residents are kept aware of any changes to planning law
3.	Given that the Parish is in favour of the current stated principles of affordable housing, to ensure that all views are taken into account in discussions with Wealden, Firle Estate and other landowners, in trying to identify suitable sites.

Theme : Transport and Access	
Three key priorities for PARISH: ALCISTON	
1.	To continue to lobby for measures to reduce the speed on the A27, to extend the existing 40mph restriction at Selmeaton to include the Alciston corner and generally persuade the Highways Agency to look at reducing the death toll on the entire stretch between Lewes and Polegate.
2.	To continue to lobby for a TRO along the Old Coach Road. A decision on this is now due in 2009 after intense lobbying during 2008 because of the unacceptable delay from ESCC in reaching a decision on this matter.
3.	To seek to reduce the speed of traffic within the village itself and to retain the village as a “no through route”

Theme : Prosperity / Employment / Economy	
Three key priorities for PARISH: ALCISTON
