<b>Theme : Environment / Green space</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND</b>	
1.	No development on dwindling amenity land
2.	Protect and improve local heritage, woodland, trees and footpaths
3.	Improve and expand recreational facilities including allotments

<b>Theme : Housing</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND</b>	
1.	Accept WDC's "Issues and Options" outcome that no further additional housing will be located in East Hoathly beyond the 75 included in the Non-Statutory plan
2.	Meet special needs such as accommodation for elderly down-sizers
3.	Facilities in parish to be upgraded to match demands imposed by increased numbers of dwellings

<b>Theme : Transport and Access</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND</b>	
1.	Correct deficiencies in speed limits
2.	Proper safe footpath and cycle-way between the villages of East Hoathly and Halland
3.	Traffic calming measures and weight restrictions on B2192 in Halland

<b>Theme : Prosperity / Employment / Economy</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND</b>	
1.	A new Community Centre is needed for the enlarged community to prosper
2.	Encourage local recruitment of staff for the new commercial developments being built on brownfield site in East Hoathly
3.	All new commercial development to be "domestic" in scale

### Theme : Health and Social Care

#### Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND

1.	A new purpose built surgery to replace the existing one that fails almost every performance measurement

#### Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND

1.	Village facilities to make up shortfalls in village school such as providing a "school hall"

### Theme : Culture / Sport / Leisure / Play

#### Three key priorities for PARISH: EAST HOATHLY WITH HALLAND

1.	Replace existing worn-out village hall and sports pavilion in East Hoathly with a purpose built building that meets the needs of a 21 <sup>st</sup> century community, allows females to take part in sport and gives the school a space for pupils to assemble and exercise and play
2.	Provide allotments and improve facilities for recreation
3.	Improve sports field
