

Parish Plan to Local Development Framework Core Strategy

Theme: Environment/Green space

1. Complete the Commons Strategy and move towards a plan of implementation
2. Improve accessibility of footpaths throughout the parish to all who wish to use them, including dog owners
3. Review waterways for any run-off and/or pollution flooding issues

Theme: Housing

1. Better understand planning enforcement to ensure parish and district council work in alignment
2. Review suitability of affordable housing sites and seek to facilitate the required infrastructure

Theme: Transport and Access

1. Improve parking availability in the central village. Work with highways to determine risk mitigation strategy and ensure any measures implemented are enforced
2. Keep the availability of the Community bus and seek funding to enable this
3. Maintain roads in good order and ensure roadsides are well kept
4. Maintain watch on county level initiatives for local transport

Theme: Prosperity / Employment / Economy

1. Support of local services via the provision of parking
2. Affordable housing

Theme: Health and Social Care

1. Ensure maintenance of local doctors facilities and pharmacy
2. Provision of NHS dentist services
3. Support for elderly residents

Theme: Learning / Education / Training

1. Support and assist the parish primary school
2. Encourage volunteer learning assistants where appropriate

Theme: Community Safety

1. Continue to support local Community Support Officer
2. Mitigate the road risks and parking to improve safety
3. Reduce the speed limit outside the school and seek extensions to the current 30mph limit to beyond Brewers Cottages towards Piltdown

Theme: Culture / Sport / Leisure / Play

1. Improve the local playground facilities by working with the Pavilion Committee (Charity)
2. Mitigate the road risks and parking to improve safety for children to cycle and obtain access to the recreation ground
3. Promote local events including the Bonfire Society, Cricket, Football and other community gatherings
