<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: HORAM</b>

<b>Theme : Transport and Access</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: HORAM</b>	
1.	Monitor parking arrangements and alter if necessary, particularly with regard to any increased demand for spaces in the car park, especially in Summer; restricted parking on the High Street and the extension of yellow lines in Hillside Drive. Parking restrictions and double yellow lines in progress in 2009.
2.	Tackle the problem of speeding traffic

<b>Theme : Prosperity / Employment / Economy</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: HORAM</b>	
1.	Provide a room for use by solicitors, pension advisers, voluntary organisations and the Citizen's Advice Bureau, etc. for one-off surgeries.
2.	A self-employed/home-workers group was the least supported option for room use, but it would clearly be valued by a proportion of those who do work at home or are self-employed.

<b>Theme : Health and Social Care</b>	
<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: HORAM</b>	
1.	Provide carers with much needed breaks with peace of mind, for example through provision of a respite care bed facility at a local nursing home, in discussion with local homes and health service providers.
2.	Investigate sponsorship and other forms of funding for improving health and social care, especially for the elderly.

<b>Three key priorities for PARISH: HORAM</b>	
1.	The option of IT Training as one of the uses of the proposed Resource Centre was the middle ranked option in terms of support.
