



From 4pm to 4.30pm LSP members will need to discuss the arrangements for considering the applications to the Wealden LSP fund.

During this time applicants can meet with other members of their group and discuss arrangements for their presentation.

Each merged session will be about 15 minutes including time for questions and debate. This can be carried out by one person from the group, or each one separately, providing the total presentation and discussion takes no more than the time allocated. A brief overview of each of the ideas outlined in the proposals is all that is required at this stage.

Although applicants have been given very little time to discuss the potential for linking each of their proposals with others in the group, it would be helpful if applicants could indicate whether they are willing to explore partnership working as outlined in Tim Sparrow's letter of 30<sup>th</sup> June.

For instance, are members of the group:

- Willing to meet on a regular basis to develop the bid and monitor activity (need not be too often)?
- Willing to share aims and objectives and agree joint targets/outputs?
- Willing to contribute from their own budgets to develop the bid?
- Interested in identifying whether there are likely to be any other agencies or organisations appropriate for inclusion in delivering this programme?
- Able to identify any other advantages in working together?
- Able to consider the possibility of achieving these actions through a joint bid with shared outputs and a single budget?
- Able to make any other comments at this stage?

Members of the LSP will be given an opportunity to question each group following their presentation.

The first group will start around 4.30pm. with the other two following on at approximately 15 minute intervals.

Applicants are invited to use the rest of the time from 4 – 6pm to talk with others in the group or sit in during the presentations to the LSP from the other groups.

After the presentations and discussion, LSP members will be invited to indicate the level of their support for each of the proposals. Funding allocations will not be made straight away but a broad funding strategy will be agreed in line with the preferences shown by the LSP and the soundness of each group bid .

Once the feedback has been processed all applicants will be contacted to discuss the way forward.
