

The majority of services were commissioned on a countywide basis but the following services commissioned specifically to support people in the Wealden area:

British Red Cross

- £140,000 over 3 years to support Carers to stay mentally and physically well.
- Carers Respite Scheme will provide support and companionship to people in their own homes for a limited period, focusing particularly on rural areas, in order to enable Carers to have a short break.
- In years 1 and 2 the scheme will be based in the Wealden area where they currently work, extending to the Lewes area and then into Rother in year 3.

Alzheimer's Society

- £225,000 over 3 years to support carers.
- Provision of Carer Support Workers in rural areas of the county: Lewes, Wealden and Rother.

Action in Sussex

- £50,310 over 3 years to support older people.
- Community development support in rural areas to help isolated vulnerable people and their carers through activities in villages in Lewes, Rother and Wealden.
- £108,066 over 3 years to support health improvement.
- The Village care programme delivering community development support and practical help for isolated, vulnerable older people in rural areas to enable them to remain active and healthy.

Recovery Partners

- £43,344 over 3 years to support people with mental health problems.
- A project to provide peer support to people with mental health problems to participate in commissioning services, support activities and consultation in Lewes, Wealden and Eastbourne.

Railway Land Wildlife Trust

- £110,000 over 3 years to support people with learning disabilities.
- Enabling adults to improve their skills through hands-on learning, interaction with paid staff and volunteers and links to organisations that provide coaching and mentoring in Lewes and Wealden.
